Australia

Australia is one of the seven continents of the world. Twenty-five million people live there. They speak English because many of their families came from England two hundred years ago. The first people in Australia were the Aborigines about 30,000 years ago, but there are only 160,000 in Australia now.

The weather is usually hot and dry, and the centre of the country, the 'outback', is a desert. It's far from the sea. Not many people live there and there are no towns. Children in the outback do not go to school every day. There are no schools. Some go to boarding schools in the cities, or towns many kilometres away, but many children stay at home and learn with a radio programme called 'School of the Air'. Pupils talk to their teachers by radio, and send their homework in by post. People can also call the 'Flying Doctor Service' by radio. Many years ago people died because there were no doctors or hospitals in the outback. Now the doctors travel by plane to visit patients and the plane takes the patients to hospital in the city.

Australian farmers have very big farms. They have many sheep on the farms. Australian wool is very famous. There are crocodile farms, too. Crocodiles are very frightening and have sharp teeth. There are many other interesting animals in Australia. Dingos are dogs, but they do not live in people's houses. They are wild, dangerous and live in the outback. Kangaroos and koalas live in the outback, too. They carry their babies in a special pocket, a pouch. Koalas are grey and have big ears. They can climb trees. Kangaroos are bigger than koalas and have very strong legs. They can jump very high and move very quickly.
